Louis XIV (1638-1715) had decreed that the decorative arts were one of the means of maintaining French prestige abroad. The decoration of Swiss watches was strongly influenced by the various artistic movements (rococo and neo-classical) that blossomed during the reign of Louis XV. Enamel-painted watch cases, which became a recognised Geneva speciality, were inspired by the works of various French painters such as Fragonard, Watteau, Boucher and Van Loo.

The French decorative arts, now synonymous with elegance, refinement, and excellence, have profoundly influenced the history of international design over the centuries.

In the early 20th century, jewellers and watchmakers transformed watches into works of art thanks to design. This approach enabled the creation of a specific identity and style inherent to each individual artist and each House.

In the 21st century, French creative talents are perpetuating this innovative spirit through inventive design, while reinterpreting shapes in a delicate, eminently poetic manner.

This artistic sensibility finds even more graceful expression thanks to technological breakthroughs that enable designers to take their creativity to its ultimate limits.

In launching her *Damoiselle D* watch and jewellery models, Véronique Muller shares her creativity with her husband Jean Muller, a watch and jewellery designer.


Their respective careers in the field of watchmaking have given them a keen awareness of the desires, needs and values required to establish a relationship of mutual trust with their exclusive clientele.

Engineers translate the sketches into 3D models, and each of the various professions contributes to giving life to these aesthetic and technical representations. The resulting "sculptures" are infused with authentic emotional appeal.
